For this workshop, please bring the following:

- painting materials you normally use including paint, brushes, easel
- one to two canvases or art panels (no larger than 12x16)
- sketch book and pencils
- a few photos of some landscapes you would like to paint
- plastic bag and paper towels
- lunch

Some of you may ask what supplies I use. Below is a list, but I know many great painters that use many different products than these. I would suggest that you use what is comfortable for you. One thing I recommend is to use the best quality products that you can afford. I paint in oils but if you prefer acrylic or watercolor please use what you prefer to work with. These are the supplies I use:

Easel: I use a Soltek easel outside, there are many good ones on the market but please NO Costco easels for outdoor workshops.

Utrecht Paint:

- Mixed White (Utrecht White)
- Cad Yellow Light
- Cad Orange
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cad Red Med.
- Manganese Violet

Graham Paint:

- Cad Yellow Deep
- Transparent Red Oxide

Windsor Newton Winton:

- Viridian Green Hue

- Eco House Odorless thinner in an outdoor Holbein container
- Flat hog hair brushes #4, #6, #8 – Hienz Jordan Brand (Flats not Brights)
- Synthetic brushes #4, #6, #8 – Princeton Brand (Flats not Brights)
- Palette Knife
- Canvas or art panels
- Shop towels (the blue paper towel)
- Plastic bag for garbage
- Sketch book and pencils
