"Pouring Light" - Letting Loose With Watercolour Pouring – Juve Furtado, October 21, 2018

Materials List

- -1/2 Sheet of Arches 140lb cold-pressed watercolor paper (or other 'artist's' quality paper)
- -Watercolor board Wood or hard foam board for stapling paper
- -Heavy duty stapler and 3/8" staples
- 2" masking tape for framing the watercolour paper
- -A large container for clean water
- -Spray bottle Windex type
- -1 inch flat brushes, #12, 8, 4 rounds and a rigger
- -Scrubber brush or flat bristle brush and a toothbrush for scrubbing
- -3-4 white saucers, plates or small cups to mix pigment for pouring & mixing
- -Art masking fluid I use Winsor & Newton
- -Gum eraser or masking tape (to remove masking)
- -Paper towels or small sponge to clean up wet areas
- -Salt shaker with table salt (for texturing)
- -Hair dryer
